

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 4, 2011**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Holton. Mayor Holton also gave the Invocation and the Pledge followed. There were three citizens who attended this meeting. Mayor Holton announced that if Councilman Armstrong does not show up we will not have a quorum and all business will be handled at the next council meeting. There was a correction to the minutes.

Robert Rogers of 3663 Ben Lyn Road stated his wife, Becky Rogers, is interested in running for Councilman Lieupo's seat. We will have to hold a special election and Ms. Rogers can get her information from the Board of Elections.

Report from City Attorney – Mr. Turner stated he researched Councilman Lieupo's situation and due to his status of being a non-resident he is ineligible to hold office. He stated the right-of-way easements of Johnston Road are in the works. Councilman Smith inquired about the TLS easements. We will need to contact Charlie Clark regarding the procedure dedicating the road.

Mayor Holton announced we will send a copy of the Resolution with a letter to DOT about closing a portion of Johnston Road. Mayor Holton again stated that Councilman Lieupo was no longer eligible to be a councilman due to his being a non-resident and we will contact the Board of Elections for special election. Mayor Holton announced there was a culvert at 3380 Carroll Ulmer Road that was washing out. There is another pot hole and wash-out at Dasher Church of Christ. Councilman Smith stated he would handle both. Mayor then proposed we pave the walking track as it is unsafe due to all the loose gravel. We have had several complaints. We received a proposal for the repaving of it. We still have SPLOST money to pay for it. Mayor Holton also discussed possible future improvements to the walking track. A citizen stated we also needed to keep the tree limbs trimmed at the track. Mayor Holton read a letter from the Parks and Recreation Department thanking us for letting them use the Community Center property for their annual bike marathon. We also received two letters from the Census Bureau and we will contact Chris Strom from Regional Development Center to handle their requests as he was Dasher's Census representative. Mayor stated there will be an informational meeting on April 14, 2011 in Tifton to discuss the future plans of DOT.

Council Concerns- Councilman Smith stated he talked to Lance Vaughn regarding our website and he will be adding an email link to the site. He announced that Ben Wisenbaker had begun working on Triple Lake Road and will bring in the gravel as discussed at the last meeting.

Citizen Responses – Mr. Rogers asked why there were so many council members absent. Mayor Holton stated one was on vacation, one had to resign and the other had forgotten about the meeting. Ms. Rogers asked for the website address. Mr. Rogers inquired about the duties that Councilman Lieupo had.

Councilman Armstrong arrived at this time and Mayor made a motion to certify this meeting with the arrival of Councilman Armstrong. She seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. This meeting then adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
