

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 5, 2010**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Mayor Allen gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There was 1 citizen who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for amendments or corrections to the minutes. There being no corrections or amendments Councilman Copeland made motion to approve the minutes, Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mr. Al Turner stated that he had received the metes and bounds information for the Sonny Eason property from Charlie Clark. Mayor asked if someone would talk to Mrs. Green to see if she would like to deed her road easement to us as well. Councilman Smith stated he would contact her. Councilman Copeland asked if we had money to pave this area? Discussion. This will be a cut-thru for the community and we are tying into the property the city already owns.

Citizen Concerns – Kristy Santos of 3362 Triple Lake Circle complained of several loose bulldogs hanging around the bus stop. These dogs have no leashes or collars on them. She has complained to the animal control and has gotten no results. Mayor suggested she go to the county commissioners. He related that HB 489 states the county is responsible for animal control and this was a community wide issue.

Mayor Comments – 2 council invitations were passed around. He reported on the drainage issue. Discussion. He also asked if other issues of the ditch report needed to be discussed. Councilman Armstrong is not in favor of 12 foot ditches being discussed. Councilman Lieupo is concerned about Mr. Hamm's property. There was more discussion regarding other areas. Mayor is to get estimates to lay pipe between Mr. Broom's and Mr. Tyson's properties. There is a ditch on Fernbank Road that is stopped up. Mayor will ask Charlie Clark for more details regarding proposed ditches. There was discussion of improvements for Zipperer Road, Dasher Road, Johnston Road, and Triple Lake public park area. Councilman Lieupo asked to table the TLS at this time until priority areas are taken care of. We will table Triple Lake Dr and Raintree Dr (intersection) at this time. The council discussed farm tile installed at cemetery with paved approaches.

Council Concerns – Councilman Copeland is still waiting on another estimate for the museum roof. Mr. Zipperer is getting materials for cabinets for the city hall. The picnic shelter is on backorder. There was discussion on the fencing post. Councilman Lieupo reported on the Ben Hill Road ditch and TLS ditch as being completed as well as the pot holes at the church being

filled in. Councilman Smith tabled his discussion regarding playground equipment until workshop meeting. Councilman Armstrong had nothing to report at this time.

Councilman Smith made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss real estate matters. Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. The public meeting was adjourned at 7:40.

Councilman Armstrong made motion to reconvene the public meeting at 7:57 p.m. Councilman Smith seconded and it carried unanimously. Councilman Smith made motion to purchase Olga Howell's property located in TLS as discussed in the Executive Session. Mayor Allen seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

There being no further business, Councilman Smith made a motion to adjourn, Councilman Armstrong seconded this meeting and this meeting was adjourned at 8:02 p.m.
