

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 2, 2010**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Councilman Copeland gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were 2 citizens who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. There being none, Councilman Smith made motion to accept the minutes, Councilman Armstrong seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Al Turner reported that Mr. Eason signed his easement. Mrs. Green is appointed as administrator of her deceased husband's estate so until this matter is in its conclusion Mrs. Green is unable to sign over her easement. Councilman Smith asked what to do with the Cowart Storage trailer that was abandoned at the Howell property. Mr. Turner said her compliance time is up so we can do what we want with it.

Citizen Concerns – Frenchy complained of a potential meth lab across the road from him. He states he has alerted the authorities.

Mayor's Comments – Mayor met with Ryan Warren and he will meet with Linda Walker regarding their property easements. He reported that the financial audit for FY09 was completed by Tommy Griffin at Gary Zeigler's office. Mayor asked for discussion or questions. There being none, Mayor made a motion to formally accept the audit. Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Mr. Griffin also related to the Mayor that we will need an audit ending June 30, 2010 because we surpassed the \$300,000 mark. We discussed whether or not to hold a meeting on Labor Day. Councilman Lieupo made motion to cancel the Labor Day meeting. Councilman Copeland seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Mayor then announced that he was buying a house outside of Dasher city limits. Mr. Turner looked through our charter and stated he would have to resign his position.

Council Concerns – Councilman Lieupo reported he is checking into signs being placed at TLS. Councilman Smith had nothing to report. Councilman Armstrong nor Councilman Copeland had anything to report.

There being no further business to discuss, Councilman Lieupo made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. This meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
