

**CITY OF DASHER  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
DECEMBER 6, 2010**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Pro Tem Copeland. Mayor Pro Tem Copeland gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were 5 citizens who attended this meeting. Mayor Pro Tem Copeland asked for corrections or additions to the October minutes. There being no corrections, Councilman Smith made motion to accept the minutes, Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

G.R. Holton was sworn in as mayor.

Report from City Attorney – Mr. Turner advised us how to present the November minutes since there was malfunction of the recording device.

Mayor Holton approved Lowndes County Board of Elections to handle our next election which is scheduled for 2011.

Citizen Concerns- There was none.

Council Concerns- Councilman Armstrong welcomed Mayor Holton. Councilman Smith welcomed the mayor. He reported the bridge is complete at TLS and there were problems with the beavers so it was recommended by the Wildlife Management that the trees be wired. Councilman Lieupo had a question about a mobile home being placed at the Coppage property. He stated Mr. Coppage would contact this office. Councilman Copeland read the preliminary rules for our properties. There was discussion regarding trash can placement. Councilman Lieupo suggested posting signs and see if that helped and the council agreed. Councilman Lieupo will get the signs made.

Councilman Smith then made a motion to close the public portion of this meeting and go into Executive Session to discuss personnel matters. This motion was seconded by Councilman Armstrong and carried unanimously. This meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.

The public meeting was reopened at 6:40. Councilman Smith made a motion to postpone approval of the Clerk and Code Enforcement salary increase until the January meeting so the CPA can work out the budget details. Councilman Copeland seconded this motion and it carried unanimously. Councilman Smith then made a motion to give a year-end bonus in the amount of \$250 to the City Clerk and \$100 to the Code Enforcement Officer. Councilman Lieupo seconded this motion and it carried unanimously.

There being no further discussion this meeting was adjourned at 6:50.
