

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JANUARY 2, 2017**

This meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Copeland at 6:00 p.m. MPT Copeland gave the Invocation and the Pledge followed. MPT Copeland asked if there were any additions or corrections to the previous minutes. Councilman Armstrong-Scott noted a typo and this was corrected. Councilman Bryan then made motion to approve the minutes with this correction and Councilman Armstrong-Scott seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. There was 1 citizen who attended this meeting.

Mr. Al Turner presented the contract for law enforcement lasting up to 5 years or a 60 day notice of cancellation. Mr. Turner kept the original for his files and 2 copies were made for this office.

Mayor Pro Tem Copeland discussed that the Christmas tree would be delayed a few days in coming down due to Bart Jones being sick. He stated he and Mr. Zipperer would try to get it down in the next week or two. He then discussed the need for replacement of various traffic signs throughout the city. He has a list of what needs to be replaced. He also stated we needed a park sign of rules and regulations for TLS Park. MPT Copeland then made a resolution to have the Lowndes County Board of Elections handle the 2017 election of the Mayor seat, Post 1 and 2. This resolution was seconded by Councilman Bryan and it carried unanimously. MPT Copeland stated that Mr. Zipperer built 2 picnic tables for the shelter at TLS. Plans for playground equipment were discussed. Councilman Armstrong Scott stated the American and state flags needed to be replaced at the round-a-bout. MPT Copeland stated he would order this upcoming week.

Councilman Armstrong had nothing to report.

Councilman Bryan had nothing to report.

Citizen Concerns- Lori Brown thanked the Mayor and Council for the improvement of the roads and for the shelter and park. MPT Copeland asked if she knew the ages of the children living at TLS so we would have an idea of what playground equipment would be most used there. She did not know the ages of the children. She also stated the roads were eroded again due to the heavy rains. MPT Copeland stated we would have to haul some fill dirt in.
