

**CITY OF DASHER  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
JANUARY 3, 2011**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Holton. Mayor also gave the Invocation and the Pledge followed. There was one citizen who attended this meeting. Mayor asked for corrections to the November 1, 2010 minutes. There being none Councilman Smith made a motion to approve the November 1, 2010 minutes, Councilman Copeland seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Mayor asked for corrections to the December 6, 2010 minutes. There being none Councilman Lieupo made a motion to approve the minutes, Councilman Copeland seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Report from City Attorney – Mr. Turner had nothing to report tonight.

Citizen Concerns- There was none.

Council Concerns- Councilman Armstrong wanted to know if there was a mowing contract for the Wisenbaker property. Someone had expressed interest in the matter. Councilman Copeland stated that Earl Zipperer is making a repair list. The Renter would be responsible for the mowing. There was discussion what to do with the extra lot and Councilman Smith will present options for it. Councilman Smith asked if Dasher is interested in adopting a burn ordinance that would apply mainly for residential areas. There have been several complaints regarding the continuous burning in Dasher. He then brought up salary increases for the Code Enforcement Officer and City Clerk. Mr. Griffin at Gary Zeigler's office has been in contact regarding the proper procedure. The budget supports the increase with the contingencies and we will not have to amend the budget. Councilman Smith made a motion to increase the Code Enforcement Officer's salary by \$5.00 per hour based on a 15 hour per month work load. Councilman Lieupo seconded this motion. Mayor Holton stated he preferred to wait until our FY12 budget and Councilman Copeland agreed. Councilman Lieupo stated we had already agreed to approve this at this meeting. The motion then carried to approve our Code Enforcement Officer's salary by \$5.00 per hour based upon a 15 hour a month work load. Councilman Smith then made a motion to approve the Clerk's salary by \$10.00 per hour salary per year. Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion. There was discussion that the raises were to be effective immediately. The motion carried unanimously. Mayor would like a monthly report on the Code Enforcement Officer's agenda. Councilman Lieupo reported there were some dead trees and debris that were removed. Councilman Copeland reported the park rules were posted as well as the sign for TLS. There was discussion of a community city wide yard sale and this will be taken up at workshop.

There being no further discussion Councilman Lieupo made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and this meeting was adjourned at 6:50.
