

**CITY OF DASHER  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
OCTOBER 2, 2010**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Councilman Copeland gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were 6 citizens who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. There being none, Councilman Lieupo made motion to accept the minutes, Councilman Copeland seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Al Turner reported that we gave Veolia an exclusive contract but does not mean that another vendor can't solicitate business on their own. Veolia's contract terminates on December 30, 2011.

Citizen Concerns – There were no citizen concerns.

Council Concerns – Councilman Armstrong reported she attended the GMA convention in Atlanta and thoroughly enjoyed it. Councilman Smith stated he had issues with the right-of-way mowing but no issues with the park and city hall mowings. He stated he would like to rebuild the bridge at the Howell property and received 3 bids. Randy McMullen was low bid. He feels a 4ft bridge would be sufficient even for mowing purposes. Discussion. Councilman Lieupo made a motion to accept Mr. McMullen's bid, Councilman Armstrong seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Councilman Lieupo had nothing to report. Councilman Copeland had nothing to report. The Dasher Day plans were finalized.

Mayor Concerns – The drainage issue was discussed at workshop. Mayor will try to get the rest of our SPLOST money from Lowndes County. Mayor Allen then turned in his resignation.

Councilman Smith then asked for this meeting to be adjourned so the council could go into Executive Session to discuss real estate matters. The public meeting was then adjourned at 6:27 p.m.

Mayor Allen then made motion to reopen the public meeting at 6:30 p.m., Councilman Copeland seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Councilman Smith made a motion to make an offer of \$89,900.00 for house and vacant lot that Georgia Christian School owns. Ronnie Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Councilman Lieupo made a motion to offer the owner of property in Dasher previously owned by B. I. Davis for \$7500.00. Edwin Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss, Councilman Lieupo made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. This meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
