

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 3, 2011**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Holton. Councilman Copeland gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were 2 citizens who attended this meeting. Mayor Holton asked for amendments or corrections to the minutes. There being no amendments or corrections, Councilman Copeland then made motion to approve the minutes, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Emanuel Zanders, Dasher's representative from the Southern Regional Commission, presented the Greater Lowndes 2030 Comprehensive Plan. He will return for approval at the November meeting. The Resolution to Transmit was signed and returned to Mr. Zanders.

Report from City Attorney – Mr. Turner stated he contacted Mr. Warren with our original offer but he has heard nothing further from Mr. Warren. Mr. Turner forwarded a copy of Lowndes County burning ordinance and made copies for our council. We will discuss this at our workshop meeting. Mr. Turner stated he has not heard from Charlie Clark. Mayor Holton stated he is to have the surveys done for TLS by the end of this week. Mr. Clark was asked to join the council at their workshop meeting.

Mayor Concerns – Mayor Holton stated all the work lists for Dasher Day have been completed except for the individual band member's names. Councilman Armstrong is supposed to secure this information. Mayor has the mail-out ready to mail. He then stated he met with all mayors of Lowndes County for the LOST negotiations. Wayne Bullard was elected to represent all the cities.

Council Concerns – Councilman Smith had nothing to report. Councilman Copeland reported he has not gotten the hay bales or pumpkins for Dasher Day but he has the tractors lined up for the parade. Mr. Zipperer has replaced the posts at the Community Center.

Citizen Responses/Concern – There were no citizen responses or concerns. Mr. Donnie Bryan attended this meeting. He is a candidate for Post 3.

There being no further business, Councilman Smith made a motion to adjourn, Councilman Copeland seconded this motion and this meeting was adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
