

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 3, 2006**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Mayor Allen gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were 6 citizens who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. There being none, Councilman Lieupo made motion to accept the minutes with the correction, Councilman Armstrong seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

There was no report from Al Turner.

Resolution adopting National Incident Management System and Unified Command System as System for Preparing for and Responding to Disaster Incidents

– Mayor Allen read this resolution in its entirety. He explained that this resolution was mandated by law and we would be able to be reimbursed for expenses incurred by natural disasters. Councilman Lieupo asked if this was something we had to adopt on a yearly basis? Mr. Turner stated this was for the federal system not the state and he did not know if we would have to do this yearly. There being no further discussion Councilman Lieupo made a motion to accept, Councilman Armstrong seconded and it carried unanimously.

Citizens Concerns: Ron Hood made a complaint about several real estate signs being posted in right-of-way at corner of Hwy 41 and Johnston Road. Greg Nolan asked the status of his ditch that is to be repaired. Councilman Lieupo discussed the recommendation he had received from our city engineer to use concrete and he is just having trouble finding someone who could do the job right away. Ben Wisenbaker had several projects to complete before he could do this one. Councilman Armstrong asked if the ditch on the other side of the road from Mr. Nolan would be addressed. Councilman Lieupo stated there was no existing ditch across from Mr. Nolan but would see what needed to be done. Frenchy asked the status of the remaining trailers at the Wisenbaker mobile home park. Mayor Allen replied that all the tenants had signed letters stating they had until the end of April. If they are not moved by then we may have to go through legal evictions. Frenchy also asked what was happening at the Porter place. Mayor told him a demolition permit was purchased and the house is being torn down piece by piece. Mr. Higgins asked was the time table would be for the ditch work. Councilman Lieupo stated 60 days but this was not carved in stone. He announced he had a copy of the proposed improvements if anyone wanted to see them.

Mayor's Discussion – Mayor Allen announced that Councilman Stewart was visiting a friend who was in ill health and Councilman Copeland was on vacation. He had nothing else to report.

Council Concerns - Councilman Armstrong had nothing to report. Councilman Lieupo stated he was playing phone tag with Mr. Charlie Copeland but had nothing else to report.

There being no further discussion, Councilman Lieupo made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Councilman Armstrong seconded this motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
