

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
AUGUST 7, 2006**

Councilmembers Present:

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Councilman Stewart gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were 6 citizens who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. There being none, Councilman Lieupo made motion to accept the minutes with the correction, Councilman Stewart seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Our attorney, Al Turner, was not present at this meeting.

Mayor Allen read the second and final reading of the ordinance for Municipal Court Services. After the reading, Mayor Allen asked for questions or discussion regarding municipal court services from the council and citizens. There being none, Councilman Stewart made a motion to approve the ordinance, Councilman Armstrong seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mayor Allen had a public reading and consideration of adoption of Resolution to Transmit Community Agenda. Anne-Marie Wolff of the SGRDC explained the mandatory process. This will be a 60 day review and she will be back in October.

Norman Bennett campaigned for his seat.

Citizens Concerns: There was no citizen concerns.

Mayor's Discussion – Mayor Allen announced the plans for the Dasher Day Celebration was going well. The food, tent/chairs, horse carriage rides as well as 2 bouncy houses was secured. We will have bottled water available throughout the day. Councilman Lieupo and Councilman Stewart are to secure the band if Councilman Copeland has not done so. Councilman Armstrong will handle taking care of the blinking signs.

Council Concerns - Councilman Lieupo contacted Charlie Clark regarding the plans for the Triple Lakes dam but he had not drawn up any plans to this date. Councilman Lieupo states this will be an expensive endeavor. He will contact Jerry Cooper who constructed this dam previously. We will submit bids for this project. He then stated he received a call from Chris Prine who had complaints about his ditch. Councilman Lieupo went over to his house and he did not deem it to be as bad as Mr. Prine did. Mayor Allen stated he was involved with the Service Delivery Strategy and states we will see how that progresses. Councilman Lieupo entertained the idea allowing a cell phone tower to be placed in Dasher. This would be revenue for the city. Councilman Lieupo stated he would investigate this possibility. Councilman Stewart had

nothing to report. Councilman Armstrong announced that Edwin Smith has been hard at work cleaning up around the signs and replacing city signs. Councilman Lieupo asked if Ms. Howell had opened up her gates at Triple Lake Subdivision. Mayor Allen stated we had received a copy of the certified letter Mr. Turner had sent her advising her to open it up. Councilman Lieupo then stated that Ms. Green had posted “No Trespassing” signs on the perpetual easement. Mayor Allen reported that the Service Delivery Strategy as well as the Comprehensive Plan has to be completed by October. He has attended two meetings so far. He encouraged the Council to attend these meetings as well.

There being no further discussion, Councilman Lieupo made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Councilman Stewart seconded this motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
