

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JANUARY 2, 2012**

This meeting was called to order by Mayor Holton at 6:00 p.m. Councilman Smith gave the Invocation and the Pledge followed. Councilman Copeland made a motion to approve the minutes, Councilman Bryan seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. There were no guests or citizens who attended this meeting.

Anita Armstrong and Edwin Smith were sworn in as councilmen for Posts 3 & 4.

Mayor discussed the Resolution of Lowndes County Multi-jurisdictional Hazardous Mitigation Plan. Mayor Holton asked for discussion or questions. There being none he entertained a motion to approve, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mr. Al Turner was unable to attend this meeting.

Mayor Holton passed a resolution to appoint Mr. Ryan Warren as our new appointee to the Greater Lowndes Planning Commission. Councilman Armstrong seconded this resolution and it carried unanimously. Mr. W. G. Walker stepped down as our representative November 2011. There was discussion of the Veolia contract. The council stated they were very pleased with Veolia and would like to continue with their services. A representative of Veolia was asked to go over, in detail, the contents of our contract. Mayor Holton then asked for authorization to get a landscape concept regarding our turnabout. There was no objection from the council. There was no new discussion on the drainage project.

Councilman Armstrong had nothing to report. There was discussion on the new policy regarding our Community Center. Councilman Smith stated the website has been updated. He reported that sand had been hauled into the park area. Mr. Smith presented a letter regarding the loose/dangerous dogs in Dasher as approved by our attorney. We will have this mailed out to all citizens. Mayor Holton stated he would handle the mailing of the letter. There was discussion of placing a bulletin board on the city hall grounds. Councilman Bryan had nothing to report. There was discussion regarding the pecans on the city property and it was decided that anyone desiring to pick them up was granted permission. Councilman Copeland had nothing further to discuss. Councilman Smith stated Mr. Zipperer needed to rent a lift to take the banners down and this request was approved.

There were no citizens concerns or comments tonight.

There being no further discussion, Councilman Copeland made motion to adjourn, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. This meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
