

**CITY OF DASHER  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
JUNE 1, 2009**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Mayor Allen gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There was 1 citizen who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. There being no corrections, Councilman Armstrong made motion to accept the minutes, Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Al Turner had nothing to report.

Mayor stated he had the plans given to him by Charlie Clark regarding TLS road and ditch work. Sealed bids must be turned in by July 6<sup>th</sup> to the clerk. Mayor then gave Al Turner a copy of the Resolution of Intent and Ordinance for FEMA flood insurance. Mr. Turner is to review and rewrite it for Dasher's use.

Citizen Concern – Mr. Higgins asked for striping to be put in place on Johnston Road. Councilman Lieupo will take care of this. Discussion.

Mayor's Discussion – Mayor stated Councilman Copeland will be out of town for the next 2 months. He had nothing further to discuss.

Council Concerns – Councilman Armstrong had nothing to report. Councilman Smith contacted Sunrise Irrigation regarding the dying grass at community center. They gave him 2 estimates for 2 more sprinkler zones. Councilman Smith stated he would like to see flower beds at back of community center. He also introduced a bid from Gene Herring to tie in pipe to mainline. Councilman Smith called the county extension agent who stated the grounds needed to be fertilized and add pesticide and herbicide. He got 3 bids for this project. Councilman Smith feels we should have the best lawns in Lowndes County. Mayor suggested the city hall and community center be treated this year and if successful we could add the park next year. Councilman Smith stated he would like the park to have at least the insecticide treatment. Councilman Armstrong made motion to run water line with 3" pipe and approved both bids from Sunrise irrigation. Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion. Councilman Smith clarified the laying of the pipes and with this clarification the motion carried unanimously. There was discussion of the lawn care bids. Councilman Lieupo made motion to approve the Herring Landscaping bid for all services for city hall and community center for a one time service. Councilman Smith stated all bids would have soil samples taken before putting in the chemicals. Councilman Smith seconded the motion. Councilman Armstrong opposed the Herring bid. Councilman Smith then stated the web site is up and running but he would like for some history notes to be included. Our web site is [dasherga.com](http://dasherga.com).

There being no further discussion, Mayor Allen made motion to adjourn, Councilman Armstrong seconded this motion and it carried unanimously. This meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
