

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 2, 2008**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Councilman Copeland gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There was 1 citizen who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. Councilman Copeland stated he did not say the county required buffering. There was discussion. Councilman Copeland then made motion to accept the minutes with correction, Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Al Turner reported that he sent a certified letter to Diversified terminating the mowing contracts. Al said it was okay for us to go ahead and get someone else to do the mowing. He did say notice was given so we do not have to do anything else nor are we responsible for payment after the notice date. Al gave us a fencing contract and Tonia will run 3 x in the newspaper and bid will be received on working days until 11:00 a.m. on July 7. The sealed bids will be opened and possibly awarded on July 7 meeting.

Citizen Concerns: Ron Hood commented that he agreed with the handling of Bobby Coppedge's special exception request. There were no complaints.

Mayor's Discussion – Mayor stated Charlie Clark is getting a signature from Southern Allied and will get his work bond and insurance. Mayor then stated Edwin was working on food prices for Dasher Day.

Council Concerns – Councilman Copeland announced that the roofer would be starting next week. He went to a meeting where Dasher was awarded a certificate of appreciation from the Historical Society. The auction has been changed to June 21, 2008 at 8:30 a.m. Councilman Lieupo would like permission to get the sign from Sam's. Councilman Copeland made a motion for Ronnie to get the sign, Councilman Armstrong seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Councilman Armstrong stated she had a list of everyone who is buried in the cemetery so we can make sure we did not miss anyone who was a vet so a marker can be placed on their grave. Councilman Armstrong then asked how many citizens Dasher had. Mayor stated 834 and Ron Hood confirmed as of the 2000 census we had 834.

There being no further discussion, Councilman Lieupo made motion to adjourn, Councilman Armstrong seconded this motion and it carried unanimously. This meeting adjourned at 6:26 p.m.
