

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 4, 2007**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen and he gave the Invocation. The Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were 3 citizens who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. There being no additions or corrections to the minutes, Councilman Copeland made motion to accept the minutes, Councilman Stewart seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

G.R. Holton was sworn in for another 2 year term of the Zoning Board of Appeals.

Sherry Davidson presented the amendments to Greater Lowndes Solid Waste Management Plan. Councilman Lieupo asked if Dasher information should be included on page 6 of the amendment. Ms. Davidson stated she would check on that. Mayor Allen then signed the resolution and original given to Ms. Davidson.

Mayor Allen read the Vehicular Traffic from Obstruction Ordinance. This was the second public reading. He asked for discussion from council and citizens. There being none, Councilman Lieupo made a motion to approve, Councilman Copeland seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mayor stated 2 bids were open for TLS dam project. Charlie Clark opened the 2 sealed bids in the office today at 11:00 a.m. Dunmon Construction Co. was awarded the low bid. There was discussion. Councilman Lieupo made a motion to table both bids due to costs. Councilman Copeland stated if we wait prices will rise again. There was discussion of the specifications of the project. There was no second to the motion. Councilman Copeland made a motion to approve the bid and award it to Dunmon Construction Co. and have Charlie Clark monitor the project. Mayor Allen was asked by Mr. Clark to order concrete and soil compaction testing. Councilman Armstrong asked what over and above costs would that be? The extra costs would be the 2 testings and Mr. Clarks fees. This project will be covered by SPLOST money. Councilman Stewart then seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Al Turner had nothing to report.

Mayor Comments – Mayor announced surveying was done at Howell property. We will need to remove the fencing and have Georgia Power remove the service pole. We will also need to remove the Howell's service pole. Mayor asked advice on how to get reimbursed for removal of the fencing and Mr. Howell's service pole. Mr. Turner stated we would send a certified letter requesting payment and if not paid we would place a lien on his property. Mr. Turner recommended that Ricky or a Sheriff's deputy be there each time service is done. Mayor stated he would find someone to remove the fencing. Mayor then announced that Ben Wisenbaker

retracted his mowing contract and Ed Hayes was awarded it. He will mow the 2nd Friday of every month.

Citizen Concerns – Frenchy thanked the council for removing the culverts at the park.

Council Concerns – Councilman Copeland stated the museum was progressing nicely. Mayor thanked him and Councilman Armstrong for their hard work. Councilman Lieupo had nothing to report. Councilman Stewart had nothing to report. Councilman Armstrong had nothing to report.

There being no further discussion, Councilman Armstrong made a motion to adjourn, Councilman Copeland seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. This meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
