

**CITY OF DASHER  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
MAY 3, 2010**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Councilman Copeland gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were no citizens attending tonight. Mayor Allen asked for amendments or corrections to the minutes. There being no corrections or amendments Councilman Copeland made motion to approve the minutes, Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Concerns – Councilman Armstrong presented a proposed sign design from Barclay Carter. The council approved the proposed design with the few changes Councilman Armstrong suggested. Councilman Smith stated he talked to Ms. Green regarding her easement. She is still considering turning over the easement to Dasher. He tabled his discussion for mosquito spraying until workshop meeting. Councilman Smith then submitted a proposal for additional playground equipment. Councilman Copeland made a motion to approve the proposal, Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. Councilman Lieupo asked about preparations for Dasher Day. The bounce houses and tables/tents have been secured. Councilman Armstrong will secure the entertainment and Councilman Smith will handle food arrangements. Councilman Copeland stated he received a complaint about the CC floor buckling but he stated it was no worse than it always has been. He then stated Mr. Zipperer will work on the bay roof so the squirrels cannot get through. Councilman Copeland stated electricity and water will be available for the new shelter.

Mr. Al Turner reported on the closing of the Howell property. He stated the plat for the Eason right-of-way is wrong and Charlie Clark will have to have it corrected. He then reported the only ditch easement recorded was the Nolan's and Christopher Walker in 2005.

Mayor Comments – Mayor Allen asked the council their opinion on the maintenance for the Howell property. He feels the bridge and dock need replacing and of course keep the grass maintained. There is an existing slab on the property. Ms. Howell was given 90 days to remove her personal belongings. Gene Herring was asked to look at this property for clearing. There was discussion regarding capping the well. Councilman Copeland would like TLS residents to give their input for their enjoyment. Councilman Smith suggested a picnic table and benches around the pond. There was discussion regarding setting hours of operation. There was more discussion regarding Dasher Day.

There being no further business, Councilman Lieupo made a motion to adjourn, Councilman Copeland seconded this meeting and this meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
