

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 4, 2009**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Councilman Smith gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were no citizens who attended the meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. There being none Councilman Lieupo made a motion to accept the minutes, Councilman Copeland seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Al Turner reported the TLS property was purchased.

Mayor Allen read the FY10 budget in its entirety. Mayor asked for discussion or questions. There being none, Councilman Copeland made motion to approve the budget, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

There was discussion regarding the GIRMA insurance. Al Turner suggested we take photographs of all our assets for protection purposes. Councilman Smith then made motion to approve GIRMA policy as is, Councilman Copeland seconded motion and it carried unanimously.

There were no citizen concerns.

Mayor Comments – Mayor Allen asked that the council put a priority on the road and ditch projects and do the work promptly to avoid aggravation. His priority list included the TLS extra culvert and drainage survey by Charlie Clark. Other projects to be considered and prioritize at a later date included new roads at TLS, Johnston Road and Zipperer Road. Mayor reported that Charlie Clark would submit his property drainage proposal as soon as the field work was complete. Mayor discussed that FEMA was offering flood insurance to citizens after the city completes its application. He asked Councilman Lieupo to remove the sign at the new property and the silt fence at the community center.

Council Concerns:

- A. Councilman Copeland announced he would be on a 2-3 month vacation starting at the end of May.
- B. Councilman Lieupo announced he had the TLS signs installed.
- C. Councilman Smith reported that Harry Flythe gave him recommendations regarding alternate mosquito control. He also requested from Councilman Copeland and

D. Councilman Armstrong reported on the Dasher signs and will coordinate with Nan Regarding the community center while clerk was on sick leave. Councilman Armstrong reported a hole at the culvert that needed repairing.
