

**CITY OF DASHER
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
OCTOBER 6, 2008**

Councilmembers Present:

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen with the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There were no citizens who attended the meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections of additions to the minutes. There was one correction to be made. Councilman Smith made motion to accept the minutes with the correction, Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mayor Allen read the Resolution # 08-02 authorizing representation for establishing a franchise fee applicable to holders of cable and video franchises issued by the State of Georgia. Councilman Lieupo made motion to accept the resolution, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and it carried. Al Turner then read Ordinance 08-03 to amend the code of ordinances of Dasher to establish a franchise fee applicable to holders of cable and video franchises issued by the State of Georgia. This was the first reading of this ordinance. The second reading and adoption is set for November 3, 2008.

Dasher Day Celebration was discussed. Councilman Smith will finalize plans with Autry's BBQ. Councilman Lieupo will bring the peanuts, hay and pumpkins. Councilman Copeland will take care of the trash bins. Councilman Smith contacted the company we bought the playground equipment from and the equipment should be delivered by October 15. Councilman Smith will also have Art Herring mow the right-of-ways around Community Center.

Mayor's Concerns— Mayor discussed that TLS is making headway but he has not talked to Charlie Clark. Mr. Clark did bring to the office a change order. Councilman Smith made motion to approve the change order. Councilman Lieupo seconded the motion and it carried. Mayor feels we need a walkway to steps of gazebo. He would like a brick pave way installed. Councilman Lieupo said he would tend to that.

Council Concerns - Councilman Smith stated he received information on grants for nature trail. He feels Dasher is not ready to proceed with application yet but hopefully we will be in a position next year to apply for it. He talked to Councilman Armstrong Saturday and she stated her husband was responding to his treatments. Councilman Smith stated the ditch across the street from Greg Nolan on Johnston Road was washed out. Councilman Lieupo will also tend to this matter. Councilman Lieupo had nothing to report.

Norman Bennett campaigned.

There being no further discussion Councilman Lieupo made a motion for adjournment, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously. This meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
