

**CITY OF DASHER  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 21, 2009**

This meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Allen. Councilman Copeland gave the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance followed. There was 1 citizen who attended this meeting. Mayor Allen asked for corrections or additions to the minutes. There being no corrections, Councilman Copeland made motion to accept the minutes, Councilman Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Citizen Concerns – Mr. Higgins thanked the council for striping Johnston Road.

Mayor's Comments – Mayor asked if there were any last minute details needed for Dasher Day. Councilman Copeland will check on trash service. Councilman Smith announced that Gayle Lavender would be providing the food.

Council Concerns – Councilman Armstrong was not present. Councilman Smith stated that people were still driving through the park even though sufficient postings are in place. There was discussion regarding additional fencing. Councilman Copeland will do the research on the fencing. Councilman Lieupo stated he was up for re-election and he is concerned that if he does not win there will be three council not certified. He would like something in place making it mandatory by resolution or ordinance for each councilmember to go the Newly Elected Training as provided by GMA. This is already a state law but it is not punishable. Councilman Smith stated he supported this. Councilman Lieupo suggested a maximum of 18 months from date of election to attend. Councilman Copeland says he doesn't feel the training is worth it and wants it to be brought up in the workshop meeting. Councilman Smith and Councilman Lieupo also want attendance for meetings mandatory and possibly not paid if they don't show up. The council will approach Al Turner on this matter. Councilman Copeland received a complaint from Earl Zipperer that a window was broken at the old city hall. Ricky Lofton was consulted. Councilman Smith is to contact the Sheriff's office to question our patrol schedule. Mr. Higgins stated he never has seen a patrol car on Johnston Road. Discussion.

Al Turner reported that he has not heard from Olga Howell. Councilman Lieupo asked Mr. Turner to research penalties for mandatory training and to research non-payment if meetings aren't attended.

There being no further discussion, Councilman Lieupo made motion to adjourn, Councilman Smith seconded this motion and it carried unanimously. This meeting adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
